

SYNOPSIS

From the award-winning visionary, Baz Luhrmann, creator of Moulin Rouge, Romeo & Juliet and The Great Gatsby, comes Strictly Ballroom, a brand-new musical for the stage inspired by the celebrated movie, starring Paul Mercurio and Tara Morice.

The phenomenally successful movie, Strictly Ballroom, premiered at Cannes Film Festival (1992) and was awarded Prix de la Jeunesse and went on to win eight AFI Awards. Luhrmann also directed the stage musical of Strictly Ballroom, which opened in Sydney in 2014.

Now Ipswich Musical Theatre Company (IMTC) is presenting the Queensland Community Theatre Premiere of Strictly Ballroom, the Musical, telling the inspiring story of Scott, a championship ballroom dancer, who defies all the rules and follows his heart, not only to find his true calling but also his true love.

DANCING:

All will be required to participate in a dance audition. Those auditioning for ensemble will learn and perform a short choreographed routine as a group. Those auditioning for particular principal roles will be taught an extended sequence. Please wear clothes that you feel comfortable dancing and moving in.

ACTING:

Those auditioning for a principal role, will be required to read a small excerpt from the script. This may be at a callback.

REHEARSALS

Rehearsals will be held Monday and Thursday evenings: 7pm to 10pm & **some** Sundays 10am to 4pm

Rehearsal venue: Old Courthouse, East & Roderick Streets, Ipswich

Rehearsals will begin in June. Full cast will come together Sunday 3rd June.

A ballroom dancing 'boot camp' will be held in May, prior to rehearsals commencing in June.

CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS

SKILLS listed in Character Descriptions are those required AT THE TIME OF PRODUCTION.

AUDITION PANEL will look for POTENTIAL in people to acquire those skills during rehearsals.

Singers, please note:

There will be a ballroom dancing 'boot camp' in May, before rehearsals begin in June.

Dancers, please note:

Musical Director, Robert Clark, will teach you to sing the songs.

Singers/Dancers, please note: If Director, Cienda McNamara, can see the potential, she may see a principal character in you.

Singers/Actors: If choreographer, Simon Lind, can see some potential for rhythm, he can teach you dance skills and routines.

TRIVIA: Tara Morice was an actress. For STRICTLY BALLROOM, Tara Morice got only 6 weeks intensive training (Latin + Ballroom) before she played 'Fran' in the movie and danced with Paul Mercurio.

CHARACTER Descriptions

SCOTT HASTINGS - Romantic male lead

Age range: 18 to 28 (playing 19 - 21)

Description: Scott has Aussie good looks, is charming, the star of the dance studio with the world at his feet. However, Scott is also rebellious and can be obsessive and angry as he discovers there is more to dancing when he begins to dance his own steps, which amaze the crowds, but break all the accepted rules of dance that he has been taught. He is a young man learning to stand up for himself and not be fearful. He is also experiencing love for the first time.

Skills: Strong, trained dancer, ballroom training a plus, acting and singing required.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

FRAN - Romantic female lead

Age range: 18 to 28 (playing 19 - 21)

Description: Fran is a girl who blossoms from the ugly awkward duckling of the dance studio into a beautiful and passionate dancer (and Scott's dance partner) as they display their breathtaking, rule-breaking new dance routine in the finale of the show. A character who undergoes a real transformation, as Fran and Scott become dance partners, fall in love and stand up for what they believe in. She is truthful, can be very direct and is strong and proud.

Skills: Strong actor/singer with dance training, ballroom training a bonus but not essential.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

SHIRLEY HASTINGS - Principal role

Age range: 45 to 60 years old

Description: Scott's mother, iron-willed matriarch of the Kendall Dance Studio. Audience should believe she was a champion dancer in her youth. She is wiry and brittle in an overly-groomed way. She's a fierce harridan whose tears are shocking, and her motto is "I've got my happy face on." She's a manipulator and bully especially to her husband and self-deceiving slave to her Ballroom Family and the Studio. "The sacrifices we've made for you, the money, the time and effort......" An Aussie battler.

Skills: Strong acting role.

DOUG HASTINGS - Principal role

Age range: 50 - 65 years old

Description: Scott's father and Shirley's husband, Great actor who carries the emotional heart of the piece. Character is mute for much of the time and appears intensely nervous, and socially inept. Dances only in Flashback Studio comic scene, one poignant solo dance scene and when he asks Shirley to dance in the finale. May not sing solo. Appears in all the Studio and Festival scenes. Able to sustain the mystery of whether his strange behaviour is that of a goodie or a baddie: keeper of the dark secret. Comically obsessive but finally heroic – "The Mouse that Roared", the tragic clown.

Skills: Strong acting role – a good mover a bonus. Must sing.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

LES KENDALL - Principal role

Age range: 45 – 60 years

Description: Proprietor of Kendall's Studio, Scott's coach who toes the Federation line. Dignified and sincere in his own way. Camp "theatrical" quality. Fruity voice and flowery delivery. He is vain about his appearance but ultimately self-deluding as to his attractiveness. Old song and dance man.

Skills: Good character actor. Good mover/dancer. Must sing.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

BARRY FIFE - Principal role

Age range: 45 - 65

Description: President of the Dance Federation. The most powerful man in Ballroom Dancing. A fleshy sweaty man. A buffoon and manipulator.

Skills: Role for a huge Falstaffian character, comic-with-a-bite actor. Must sing.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

J.J. SILVERS – Principal role

Age range: 25 - 55 years old

Description: Master of Ceremonies at Festivals. Federation Man.

Skills: Good comic skills, must be able to interact with the audience and ad lib if required. Must sing.

LIZ HOLT - Supporting role

Age range: 18 - 25 years old

Description: Scott's partner of fifteen years, immaculately over-groomed yet has a screeching vocal quality and howls like a banshee with a nasal voice and hysterically screaming if she doesn't get her own way. She is ruthlessly ambitious and determined to win the Pan Pacific Championships yet underneath she is quite brittle. A young Shirley Hastings.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

VANESSA CRONIN - Supporting role

Age range: 18 - 25 years

Description: Liz's best friend and Wayne's partner. Warm, very attractive but not very bright.

Skills: Good ballroom dancer; strong actor. Must sing.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

WAYNE BURNS - Supporting role

Age range: 19 to 25 years old

Description: Scott's best mate. Vanessa's dancing partner & fiancé. Loyal Kendall Studio member and he carries much of the plot. Boy-next-door or quirky looks with comic naivete. Aggressively ambitious drive. He dances to win. Sporty rather than arty by day – a car mechanic – and is bewildered with Scott's search for real dance!

Skills: Strong actor & dancer. Must sing.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

RICO - Supporting role

Age range: 40's to 50's

Description: Fran's father. Strict 'Spanish' despot. Intense, fiery, excitable.

Skills: Flamenco Dancer who inspires Scott with the 'real Spanish rhythm'.

Strong actor who speaks Spanish or is willing to learn Spanish. Ability to sing a bonus.

ABUELA - Supporting role

Age range: 60's

Description: Fran's Spanish grandmother. She is kind and supportive of her granddaughter. Excellent sense of rhythm. Strong actor, who speaks Spanish, or is willing to learn Spanish. Ability to sing a bonus.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

KEN RAILINGS - Minor role

Description: A waning ballroom star, desperate to make a comeback.

Skills: Strong dancer, actor, singer.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

TINA SPARKLE - Minor role

Age range: 25 - early 30's

Description: Stunningly tall gazelle-like dancer, current Pan Pacific champion. She has a beautiful body,

however, is not very bright.

Skills: Very good ballroom dancer, strong actor, must sing.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

CLARRY WRENCH - Minor role

Age range: 30 - 40 years old

Description: Beginner dance member of Kendall's Studio. Sometime partner of Natalie.

Vocal range: No Vocal range specified.

CHARM LEACHMAN - Ensemble

Age range: 40 - 50 years old

Description: The Federation District Co-ordinator. Barry's partner in crime - tall, taut and sinewy. Authoritarian, steely and ruthlessly loyal to Barry and the Federation. We should believe she was a

champion dancer in her day.

Skills: Strong dancer. Good actor. Must sing.

PAM SHORT - Ensemble

Age range: 20 - 30 years

Description: Ballroom dancer. Acting and singing skills required.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

NATALIE - Ensemble

Age range: 18 to early 20's

Description: Fran's best friend and dance partner.

Skills: Ballroom dancer. Acting & singing skills required.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

NATHAN STARKEY - Ensemble

Age range: 25 - 35 years old

Description: "Golden Boy" good looks and physique who is about to retire as Tina Sparkle's partner and Pan Pacific Champion to concentrate on his landscape gardening business.

Skills: Very strong 'Federation' Ballroom Dancer. Acting and singing skills required.

Vocal range: No vocal range specified.

TERRY BEST - Ensemble

Age range: 35 - 60 years old

Description: Tina's coach

MERV - Ensemble

Age range: 35 - 50 years

Description: A middle-aged Federation official.

MALE Ensemble of Singers & Dancers 18 to 30's
